

The role of a Course Ambassador:

As an Ambassador for your course you will gather in the viewpoints, comments and suggestions from other learners on your course then present them informally to other course ambassadors during the Learner Forum, which will be held for 1 hour once every half term.

The role will offer you the chance to:

- Ensure you and your peers get a voice, helping us to work together to improve the services we offer our learners
- Meet a range of people
- Develop your communication, negotiation, information gathering and interpersonal skills
- Develop your ability to build and manage relationships with a diverse range of people
- Show employers that you can put your skills into practice in a work environment and will allow you to give strong examples of how you have proven this

In addition and only should you wish, you can decide to help prospective students learn more about their programme of choice by meeting and speaking with them during Open Events etc. You can also become further involved by sharing your experience and choices in relevant marketing materials such as the website, newsletter and any promotional materials.

Other opportunities to represent Building Futures East may arise throughout the year, in which case we will approach those Ambassadors whose skills and capabilities match those of the specific task. Like all Ambassador activity, you will of course have the right to decline to participate in any activity.

Suitable Ambassadors should demonstrate:

- enthusiasm
- non-bias so that they are able to represent and voice all the viewpoints of their fellow learners
- commitment to participating in the Learner Forum meeting whilst on course
- a willingness to commit to participating in additional specific activities as mentioned above
